

Over the coming weeks your trainer will follow the class timetable using remote learning.

Remote learning means that you will continue your studies from home or in some cases from the workplace. Your trainer will communicate with you in various ways which may include video conferencing, phone and emails.

How you communicate with your trainer may depend on the course you are studying and your access to a computer and the Internet. Don't worry if you don't have a computer or Internet access. GOTAFE will arrange to mail any print-based resources you need.

Are you using goLearn or another online platform?

If you use goLearn or another online platform this will continue. The face-to-face class components of your course will be moved to the online platform, and videoconferencing classes will be offered. You can use a computer or another device such as an iPad or smartphone for video conferencing. Your teacher will send you instructions and a link inviting you to join an online remote learning class.

Are you attending classes at a GOTAFE campus? Do you use a text book or other print resources?

If you attend classes at a GOTAFE campus using print-based resources such as a text book or student workbook you will use the same resources for remote learning. However, rather than attending classes at TAFE you will move to an online remote learning class using a computer or other device such as an iPad or smartphone for video conferencing. Your teacher will send you instructions and a link inviting you to join an online remote learning class.

Does your course have Practicals, Workshops or Lab sessions?

If your course has practical assessments or face-to-face sessions such as workshops or lab sessions, these will be delayed. Your trainer will organise for these sessions to be conducted in intensive blocks once we are back on campus.

Does your course have Work Placements?

Your trainer will let you know the arrangements for work placements.

Are you an Apprentice or Trainee?

Your trainer will let you know the arrangements for continuing your training with GOTAFE as a remote learner.

Has your course been suspended?

Some courses may be suspended; in particular if your course is mainly practical. If your course is suspended your trainer will let you know when classes start again.

Learning support

Talk to your trainer about any questions or concerns you may have with remote learning. The Learning Support unit (LSU) can also help you. You can get a referral to the LSU from your Course Coordinator, or contact learningsupport@gotafe.vic.edu.au and a Learning Support Officer will get back to you. You also have access to Studiosity online 24/7 (any day, any time).
